This programme will give participants the necessary qualification to teach the new QCF Level 2 Door Supervision Awards.

Important Information

The SIA will require all Door Supervisor trainers to hold the new Level 3 PI Instructors qualification for any courses run after 1st August 2010.

Current Trainers

Current trainers who already hold a Delivery of Conflict Management Trainer's qualification as well as a Teaching Award will be required to complete a Level 3 Physical Intervention Trainers qualification in order to teach the QCF programme.

New Trainers

Candidates who are not currently qualified to teach but wish to gain accreditation to teach the new QCF Level 2 Door Supervision Award will be required to hold a Conflict Management Trainer's Award and PTLLS Adult Teaching Trainer Award (or equivalent) before they can be accepted on the PI level 3 Trainer Accreditation programme.

Training Information

Overview

The purpose of the training programme is to give candidates skill in the application and teaching of approved PI techniques. These are designed specifically for the purpose of non-aggressive intervention and personal safety, and are drawn from the list of approved techniques as set out in SIA guidelines.

The course itself will give candidates a wide range of skills and technical understanding that will allow them to adapt the course material so that it can be used in the most appropriate way depending of the requirements of the individual clients.

Course contents will be delivered through a mixture of classroom theory, physical understanding of the techniques and practical teaching experience.
